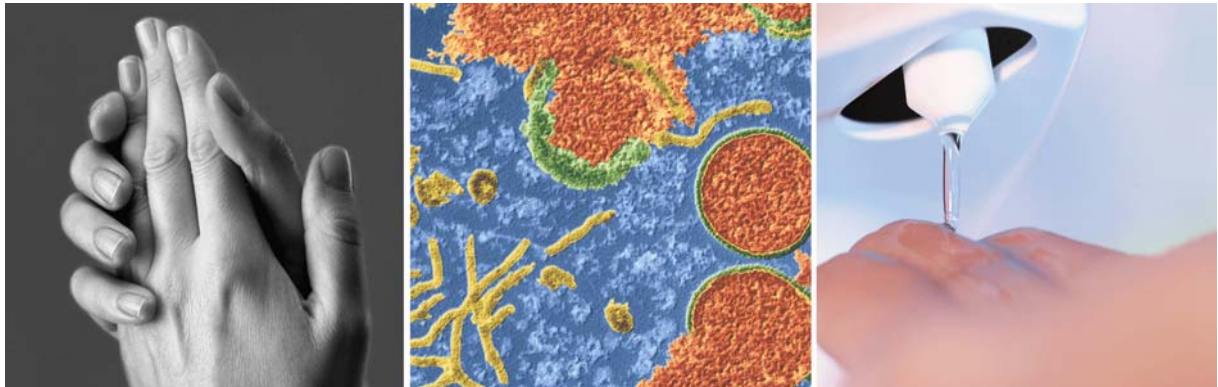

## Composition

100 g solution contain:

Active substance: Ethanol 99 % 80 g.

Other ingredients: Butan-2-on, purified water, heptamethylnonan, (2-ethylhexyl)(2-ethylhexanoate), tetradecan-1-ol, (RS)-5-oxo pyrrolidin-2-carboxylic acid, (RS)-5-oxo pyrrolidin-2-carboxylic acid, sodium salt.

Manusept® basic is

- bactericidal
- yeasticidal
- tuberculocidal
- virucidal against enveloped viruses (incl. HBV, HIV, HCV)\*

In addition, Manusept® basic is active against rotavirus.

Virucidal against enveloped viruses (incl. HBV, HIV, HCV) 30 s

Vacciniavirus + BVDV

### Nonenveloped viruses

Rotavirus 30 s
